AMERICAN NEGRO ACADEMY IS FOUNDED

Founded on March 5, 1897, in Washington, D.C., the American Negro Academy (ANA) was created by Alexander Crummell as the first national organization of Black scholars in the United States.

The Academy directly challenged scientific racism and disenfranchisement, helping establish scholarship as a powerful weapon in the struggle for civil rights and laying groundwork for future generations of Black intellectual and cultural movements.

PLAYWRIGHT CHARLES FULLER IS BORN

Charles Fuller was born on March 5, 1939, in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He co-founded the Afro-American Theatre of Philadelphia, writing early plays like The Village: A Party (1968), which later ran off-Broadway as The Perfect Party.

His most celebrated work, *A Soldier's Play* (1981), written in honor of his friend Larry Neal, won the 1982 Pulitzer Prize for Drama, the New York Drama Critics' Award, and the Edgar Award. Fuller adapted it into the Academy Award-nominated film *A Soldier's Story* (1984), cementing his legacy as one of America's most influential playwrights.



Poll Shows Support for Policies That Help Families Afford Child Care

By First Five Years Fund

New national polling shows persistent voter concern about the affordability and availability of child care for working parents.

The national survey was conducted by UpOne Insight on behalf of the First Five Years Fund from January 13–18, 2026.

KEY FINDINGS INCLUDE:

- **Parents need help:** 80% of voters say the ability of working parents to find and afford child care is either in a state of crisis or a major problem.
- **This is an affordability issue:** 82% believe federal child care funding will help lower costs for working families — including 69% of Republicans, 84% of Independents, and 94% of Democrats.
- **And there continues to be strong support (62%) for the Child Care and Development Block Grant (CCDBG),** a federal program that makes it possible for hundreds of thousands of families to afford safe, quality care for their children while parents work or go to school, including a majority of Republicans, 63% of Independents and 72% of Democrats.
- **Support for funding child care programs remains strong:** 75% believe child care funding should be increased or kept at current levels — including 75% of Republicans, 85% of Independents, and 97% of Democrats.
- 74% say funding for child care is an important and good use of tax dollars, including a majority of Republicans, three-quarters of Independents, and nine in ten Democrats.
